

USERS OF THE TEMPORARY CHILDREN'S ROOM WHILE THE LIBRARY IS UNDER RENOVATION

For the remainder of the Hal Bloom Young Adult Center construction project, the Children's Room will be intended for use by children up to 8th grade (or whose age is that of an 8th grader) or those accompanying a child whose age is that of an 8th grade student or younger.

Young adults in high school (or those who are of high school age) may visit the children's room to retrieve materials or browse. However, sitting or reviewing materials in depth must be done in the upstairs area of the library. Computer use for this age group is restricted to the upper level of the library.

The upstairs area of the library will be intended for use by all Young Adults in 9th grade or older (or whose age is that of a 9th grader or older). Children whose age is that of an 8th grader or younger must be accompanied by an adult when occupying the upstairs area of the library.

Use of all library facilities are ultimately at the discretion of the library staff.
