

USERS OF THE CHILDREN'S ROOM

The Children's Room contains materials suitable for children under the age of 13 and is designed to provide a safe and comfortable space for children of their own age. Accordingly, access to the Children's Room is intended to be limited to:

- those under the age of 13
- those persons who are accompanying or assisting children under the age of 13 in selecting materials
- those persons 13 years of age or older for whom such material is appropriate for their reading abilities, while browsing only
- those persons 13 years of age or older who are accompanied by an aide and for whom browsing, sitting, or reviewing materials in the Children's Room is appropriate for their developmental level
- those parents or guardians who are selecting materials for the use of their children, while browsing only

Other adults and persons over the age of 13 are encouraged to use the adult area of the library for browsing, sitting, or reviewing materials in depth.

The Library reserves the right to direct patrons to the appropriate areas of the library.
